

## Short manual testo 540



- ① Protection cap: Park position

### Basic settings

Instrument off  $\geq$  press and hold 0 2s > select with 0 ( $\blacktriangle$ ),

confirm with 🚾 (🛶 ):

### Auto off function: OFF, ON

### Switching the instrument on

Press 🙆.

### Switching the display light on (for 10s)

Instrument on > press 🙆

### Select display size

Instrument on > select with a :

lux, ftc

### Select display mode

Instrument on > select with 6:

Current reading > Hold: Readings are held > Max: Maximum values > Min: Minimum values

### Switching the instrument off:

Instrument on >press and hold @2s.

The testo 540 is an illuminance measuring instrument. It is normally used to measure illuminance, e.g. at workplaces.

# **Product description**

# At a glance



- 1 Protection cap: Park position
- ② Light sensor
- ③ Display
- ④ Control keys

# First steps

### > Inserting batteries:

- 1 To open the battery compartment, push the battery cover down.
- 2 Insert batteries (2x 1.5 V type AAA). Observe the polarity!
- **3** To close the battery compartment, push the battery cover back on.
- > Basic settings (configuration mode):

### Adjustable functions

- $\cdot$  Auto off function: OFF, ON (instrument switches off automatically if no key is pressed for 10 minutes)
- When switching the instrument on, press and hold <sup>(</sup> until ▲ and <sup>(</sup> appear on the display (configuration mode).
  - The adjustable function is displayed. The current setting flashes.
- 2 Press (A) several times until the desired setting flashes.
- 3 Press 🚾 (-) to confirm the input.
  - The instrument changes to measuring mode.

# Using the product

**1** To guarantee correct readings: Hold the instrument horizontally so that the light sensor is directed upwards.

### Switching the instrument on:

- Press (1).
  - Measuring mode is opened.

### Switching the display light on:

- The instrument is switched on.
- > Press 🙆.
  - The display light goes out automatically if no key is pressed for 10 seconds.

### Changing the parameter unit:

> Press 🛆 until the desired unit appears.

#### Adjustable units

- · lux
- · ftc
- Changing the display view:

#### Adjustable views

- Current reading
- · Hold: Readings are held.
- $\cdot\,$  Max: Maximum values since the instrument was last switched on or last reset.
- $\cdot\,$  Min: Minimum values since the instrument was last switched on or last reset.
- > Press everal times until the desired view appears.

### Resetting Max/Min values:

- 1 Press everal times until the desired view appears.
- 2 Press 🕯 and hold until ---- appears.
- 3 Repeat steps 1 and 2 for all values that are to be reset.

### Switching the instrument off:

> Press () and hold until the display goes out.

# Maintaining the product

### > Changing batteries:

- 1 To open the battery compartment, push the battery cover down.
- **2** Remove used batteries and insert new batteries (2x 1.5 V type AAA). Observe the polarity!
- **3** To close the battery compartment, push the battery cover back on.

### > Cleaning the housing:

> Clean the housing with a moist cloth (soap suds) if it is dirty. Do not use aggressive cleaning agents or solvents!
