

FIRST TIME SETUP





1 Administrator Setup



 You will need to create an Administrator for the software by filling in the required information in the setup wizard. Make sure you keep a note of your login details!

2 Email Settings



 You may need to ask your IT support or email service provider for the required details. More information can be found in the software's helpfile.
If you aren't sure of the details, you can skip this step and come back to it later.

3 Software Settings



 These are global settings that apply to all users of the software, some of which are required as part of the 21CFR standard.

4 Create Additional Users



 Additional users can then be set up from the Admin menu if required. New users will be asked to create a password when they first log in.

REPLACING YOUR DATA LOGGER'S BATTERY

Your data logger is provided with a 3.6V 1/2AA battery already installed. You can change the battery by following the instructions below.



STARTING YOUR DATA LOGGER



Click on the 'Set up and start the USB data logger' button.



Name your logger and select the logging rate.



Select how the LCD should function, and what happens when your logger is full.



Set high and low alarms if required.



Set restrictions for stopping the logging session.



Select when you would like the logging session to start.



Your logger is now ready for use. Remove from the USB port.
